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## **materials:**

- Wool in red, white, black, red, gray and blue
- 3.5 mm crochet hook
- Sewing needle
- Stuffing

## **abbreviations:**

ch - chain  
slst - slip stitch  
sc - Single crochet  
inc - increase (make 2 sc in one sc)  
dec - sc decrease (sc2tog)  
Rnd - round  
rsc - everse sc  
bckl - in back loop of stitch

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**right side panel:** color red

**middle section:** start with color red

CH 21

Row1-49	20
black color change (the bottom)	
Row50-69	20

**eye 2x:** start with color black

5 sc in magic ring, blue color change

Rnd1 \*inc\* repeat times (10 sc)

embroider with the white thread of light (about 1 clock)



**windscreen:** color white

Ch 16

Row1+2 16 sc

Row3 dec, 11, dec (13)

Row4 dec, 9, dec (11)

Row5 dec, 3, dec (5)

Row6 dec, 1, dec (3); cut off a long thread to sew on the car



**rear window:** color grey

Ch 15

Row1 14 sc

Row2 dec, 10, dec (12)

Row3 12 sc

Row4 dec, 8, dec (10)



**right side window:** color grey

Ch 15

Row1 14 sc

Row2 dec, 12 (13)

Row3 dec, 9, dec (11)

Row4 dec, 9 (10)

Row5 dec, 6, dec (8)

Row6 dec, 6 (7)  
Row7 dec, 3, dec (5)

**left side window:** color grey

Ch 15  
Row1 14 sc  
Row2 12, dec (13)  
Row3 dec, 9, dec (11)  
Row4 9, dec (10)  
Row5 dec, 6, dec (8)  
Row6 6, dec (7)  
Row7 dec, 3, dec (5)

**lamp 2x:** color white

8 sc in magic ring



**mouth:** color white

Ch 5  
Row1 4  
Row2 inc, 2, inc (6)

all around with rsc, begin at the left side, for the mouth-angle right/left Ch 5



**wheel 4x:** start with color red

6 sc in magic ring; gray color change

Rnd1 \*inc\* repeat 6 times (12 sc)  
Rnd2 \*sc in next sc, inc\* repeat 6 times (18 sc)  
black color change  
Rnd3 \*sc in next 2 sc, inc\* repeat 6 times (24 sc)  
Rnd4 \*sc in next 3 sc, inc\* repeat 6 times (30 sc)  
Rnd5 \*sc in next 4 sc, inc\* repeat 6 times (36 sc)  
Rnd6 bckl sc in each sc around - 36 sc  
Rnd7+8 36 sc  
Rnd9 bckl sc \*sc in next 4 sc, dec\* repeat 6 times (30 sc)

Rnd10        \*sc in next 3 sc, dec\* repeat 6 times (24 sc)



**some spoiler page 2x:** color red

Ch 15

Row1        14

Row2        dec, 10, dec (12)

Row3        dec, 8, dec (10)

Row4        dec, 6, dec (8)

Row5        dec, 4, dec (6)

Row6        dec, 2, dec (4)

Row7        dec, dec (2)

Row8        dec + Ch1; partial collapse and close to the side with slip stitch

**middle section spoiler:** color red

Ch 17

Row1-3      16

Row4        bckl sc in each sc arow - 16 sc

Row5+6     16

partial collapse of the fracture edge and on the long side with chain stitch  
crochet, use the same long thread to sew on to the car.

**nameplate:** color white

Ch11, three rows then embroider with black thread the child's name

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**completion:**

- sew the eyes on the windscreen
- create a side part to the middle part right sides together and sew  
(now the window sew small items, lamps and mouth)
- shake up the car and sew the second side, 4 cm before the end overturn the  
car again, nice stuff firmly and sew the rest
- sew the wheels at the bottom
- the side panels and the spoiler spoiler center section sew, sew the spoiler on  
the back of the car just below the rear window
